Auto Title East Renovations Delay Monday Opening Time

Franklin County Clerk of Courts Maryellen O'Shaughnessy announced that this Monday, May 1 Auto Title East branch, at 1583 Alum Creek Drive, will open at 10 a.m. This delayed opening time is the result of renovations and facility improvements expected to be completed at the eastside location by this weekend. The remodeled title office will continue to serve customers until 5 p.m. on Monday, and resume its normal weekday business hours schedule of 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. beginning Tuesday, May 2.

Clerk O'Shaughnessy's three other title offices' schedules will not be affected and will maintain normal hours of operation as follows:

Auto Title West	4153 W. Broad St.	Weekdays 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Saturdays 8 a.m. to noon
Auto Title South	45 Great Southern Blvd.	Weekdays 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. (no Saturday hours)

Auto Title East will be open this Saturday, April 29 from 8 a.m. to noon continuing with these normal Saturday hours of operation in the new space.
